

## Caithness – Frequently asked questions

Q. **How long is the journey from Inverness?**

A. Approximately 2 and ½ hours drive through spectacular Highland Scenery

Q. **Is the mobile home in the middle of nowhere?**

A. No, it is a quiet location but only 1 mile to nearest shop

Q. **How far is the supermarket?**

A. Nearest well-stocked village shop is 5 miles (also petrol station & cash machine) big supermarkets being Tesco, Lidl, Co-op, post office, other shops etc. Are in Thurso (11 miles) and Wick (15 miles)

Q. **What is the weather like?**

A. The weather in Caithness is very changeable it is often said you can get 5 seasons in one day. It can be very hot and sunny (July/August you can get the midges – bring your repellent), it can also be very windy & rainy. Many people think all we get is really cold weather & snow – this is not the case as it is on the gulf stream the weather can be much warmer than you think, but always be prepared when it is good there is nowhere more beautiful on earth but when it is bad it is bad.

Q. **Is there somewhere to exercise my dog?**

A. Yes there is 2-acre area of moorland next to the caravans, many places to walk with dogs, beaches, forests, single-track lanes.

Q. **What type of people would enjoy Caithness?**

A. Caithness is a haven for outdoor enthusiasts, walkers, fishermen, bird-watchers, cyclists, surfers, beach combers – anyone who loves the great outdoors will enjoy what Caithness has to offer – it is not a place for people who want lots of organised entertainment
