

The Old Coach House – Frequently asked questions

Q. **Is the cottage near to the town?**

A. The cottage is up out of the town in a lovely quiet location, but yet only a 10-minute walk into the town or a couple of minutes drive.

Q. **Is there basic supplies at the cottage for my arrival?**

A. Yes all basic amenities are at the cottage i.e. washing-up liquid, toilet rolls, tea, coffee, sugar, milk, tea-towels, bin-bags, general cleaning items, kitchen roll etc.

Q. **Can I take my pet?**

A. Pets are accepted for an extra charge but must be kept under control and not allowed on furniture or left unattended. The garden must be kept clear of all fouling.

Q. **Is there space to park my car?**

A. There is ample car-parking space, large drive with enclosed gates.

Q. **What is the heating in the cottage?**

A. Gas central heating, also electric stove in living room. The cottage is a very warm and cosy cottage, the heating is on a timer to come on throughout the day and radiators can be controlled by individual thermostats.

Q. **Is there anyone nearby if we have any problems?**

A. Yes there is a caretaker who lives nearby and will be on-hand should any problems occur.

Q. **Is there landline telephone & internet facilities?**

A. No not at this present time.

Q. **Is there plenty of places to go out to eat in Pitlochry?**

A. Yes there is a good selection of places to eat in Pitlochry and surrounding areas.
